There's a car park with hundreds more spaces only 400 yards away.


York train station is just a 15 minute walk, or short taxi journey, for your guests travelling from further afield.




The Great Hall 17.7 x 8.2m (58 x 27ft)



Formal banquet - 120 pax




Banqueting rounds with top table - 90 pax




Theatre style - 120 pax

These plans show sample layouts but every client's requirements are different, so please contact us to discuss how the Hall can meet the unique needs of your wedding.






